THIS WEEK'S SPECIAL COLLECTION

At this weekend's Masses, a second collection will be taken up in support of Catholic Charities Archdiocese of New Orleans. The collection raises undesignated dollars for Catholic Charities to respond to the needs of the poor and vulnerable across the eight civil parishes of the Archdiocese. Last year, Catholic Charities served 105,594 people including expectant mothers, the homeless, children and adults with severe developmental delays, and the poverty-stricken.
