Dear Friends of Jesuit Church,

Let me begin with an apology for the "obnoxious" drawing on the other side of this page, but my hope is that through it I've caught your intention about a recent development in our parish's stewardship program.

As you know, parishioners and friends of Immaculate Conception (Jesuit) Church support the operation of this parish and its ministries through a variety of means. Sometimes this is spoken of as a sharing of "time, talent, and treasure." Financially, one of the methods through which folks contribute to the life of the parish is through **on-line giving**.

Of course, some parishioners are already regular on-line givers. If so, you should have received an email last week announcing a substantial upgrading in our on-line technology. That change means having to sign-up once again for the on-line giving option. The great news is that it is very easy. Just log-on to the parish website ([www.jesuitchurch.net](http://www.jesuitchurch.net)) and hit the "Giving" tab. The directions from there are as easy as can be.

And this is certainly a good time to consider on-line giving if you have not yet done so. Again, log-on to the parish website and hit the "Giving" tab. On-line giving is easy to navigate for the user—and, it's easy for the parish to manage. With the new system, Jesuit Church will inevitably win. (Among the potential savings is the cost of printing and sending envelopes to parishioners who move from contribution envelopes to electronic giving.)

One of the advantages of the new on-line technology is its flexibility. I am particularly eager to hear your comments and suggestions. Please don't hesitate to give me— or Cathy Brown in the parish office—your feedback. And, if you need any help whatsoever in getting introduced to this new resource, please contact us. Finally, let me say again, Thank You! Your support of the parish makes so much good happen. I remain grateful to God that he allows me to be a parishioner with you and pastor for you.

**\$2 PARKING at 220 O’Keefe**

Parking at a reduced fee of \$2.00 for a 3-hour period is available in the **CENTRAL PARKING GARAGE** at 220 O’Keefe, next to the Quality Inn, near the corner of O’Keefe and Common. The garage is open to parishioners on Sunday mornings beginning around 7 o’clock, and then again beginning around 6 p.m.

***To get the reduced rate, you must use a magnetic voucher card available for purchase in the parish office, Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.***

To take advantage of the reduced rate, enter the garage from O’Keefe, and take a ticket from the auto attendant. **KEEP YOUR TICKET.** When you exit the garage, you will need to insert both that ticket and the voucher.
